Elderly Homeless Report Review



- **Strategic Plan Objective:**
 - Collect additional data on location and needs of elderly homeless, develop and implement a plan in collaboration with partners to address needs
- **Patient Population**
 - Patients 62+ seen by HCH in 2018
 - 382 patients seen at 2,150 visits

Elderly Homeless Report Review



HCH Visit Diagnosis		Percent of Patients	HCH Activities
1.	Essential Hypertension	28%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HRSA clinical measure: ongoing monitoring via dashboard and annual reporting - Home blood pressure monitoring cuffs
2.	Substance Use Disorders (Alcohol, Opioids, Tobacco)	24%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HCH QI Priority 2019 – 2021 - All HCH providers waived to offer MAT services - HCH low-threshold Buprenorphine program
3.	Wound/Injury	20%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide wound care at all clinic sites including outreach - Provide wound care education and supplies to patients - Connect patients to wound care clinic if needed
4.	Mental Health Conditions (Depression, Anxiety, PTSD)	18%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HCH QI Priority 2019 – 2021 - Homeless Mental Illness Outreach Team - BH services available for all hotel residents - Psychiatry at all sites
5.	Diabetes	15%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HRSA clinical measure: ongoing monitoring via dashboard and annual reporting - HCH QI Priority 2019 – 2021 - Follow up referral que for poorly controlled diabetics (delayed)
